About the course

A 5-day intensive course comprises concepts in economic evaluation study design; techniques of economic appraisal including cost-minimization analysis, cost-effectiveness analysis, cost-utility analysis and cost-benefit analysis; an understanding of standard methodology including sensitivity analysis, discounting, willingness to pay and health state utility measurement; and procedures and roles in decision making for resource allocation in health care.

- * Defining the question for the economic evaluation
- * Developing protocol for an economic evaluation
- * Interpretation of incremental cost-effectiveness ratio (ICER)
- **★** Issues in measuring ICERs
- * Handling uncertainty in economic evaluation
- *Incorporating sensitivity analysis in an economic evaluation
